What is this contribution about?

A successful collaboration between researchers in astrophysics and art students and teachers from a secondary school in Padova.

Why is it relevant / interesting?

We experienced the challenge of interbreeding the scientific description of a relativistic jet of a powerful galaxy and the artistic assimilation and subsequent representation of it.

What have we done?

We have collaborated with three talented students of the secondary school and their teachers to create graphical material for a scientific conference.

What is the result?

The students elaborated excellent and innovative graphical material used for the webpage as well as the conference poster. The quality of the graphics was so excellent that one of their drawings became the cover of the February 2020 issue of the prestigious Nature Astronomy journal.
