

Chris Ndiitwani research activity focuses on modelling the modulation of galactic cosmic ray in the heliosphere, under the supervision of Prof Marius Potgieter at the North-West University, in South Africa. He obtained his PhD in 2011 from University of Kwazulu-Natal (UKZN) and began his research career when he joined the NWU as a postdoctoral fellow in the same year 2011. After two years as a “posdoct” he joined NWU as a Physics Senior lecturer and a member of the Center for Space Research in year 2014. He is an active participant in the collaborations of Italian/Russian PAMELA Space Missions for the detection of cosmic anti-particles as signatures of Dark Matter. He has co-authored 8 refereed journal publications and he is a member of the South African Institute of Physics.
